The appropriate general provisions contained in the Wasco County Road Utility Permit Ordinance as supplemented and modified by the following Special Provisions, shall apply to this permit, and by this reference are made a part hereof. It shall be the obligation of the applicant to obtain said general provisions from the County and to determine which of the various provisions are applicable before commencing work under this permit.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

1. §42.400 of this Ordinance, regarding bond, shall/shall not* apply during initial installation of facilities. If applicable, bond in the amount of \$_____ is required.

2. Open cutting of the paved or surfaced portion of the County road under §43.400 of the Ordinance is/is not* permitted. If permitted, it shall be limited to those areas indicated on the attached exhibit.

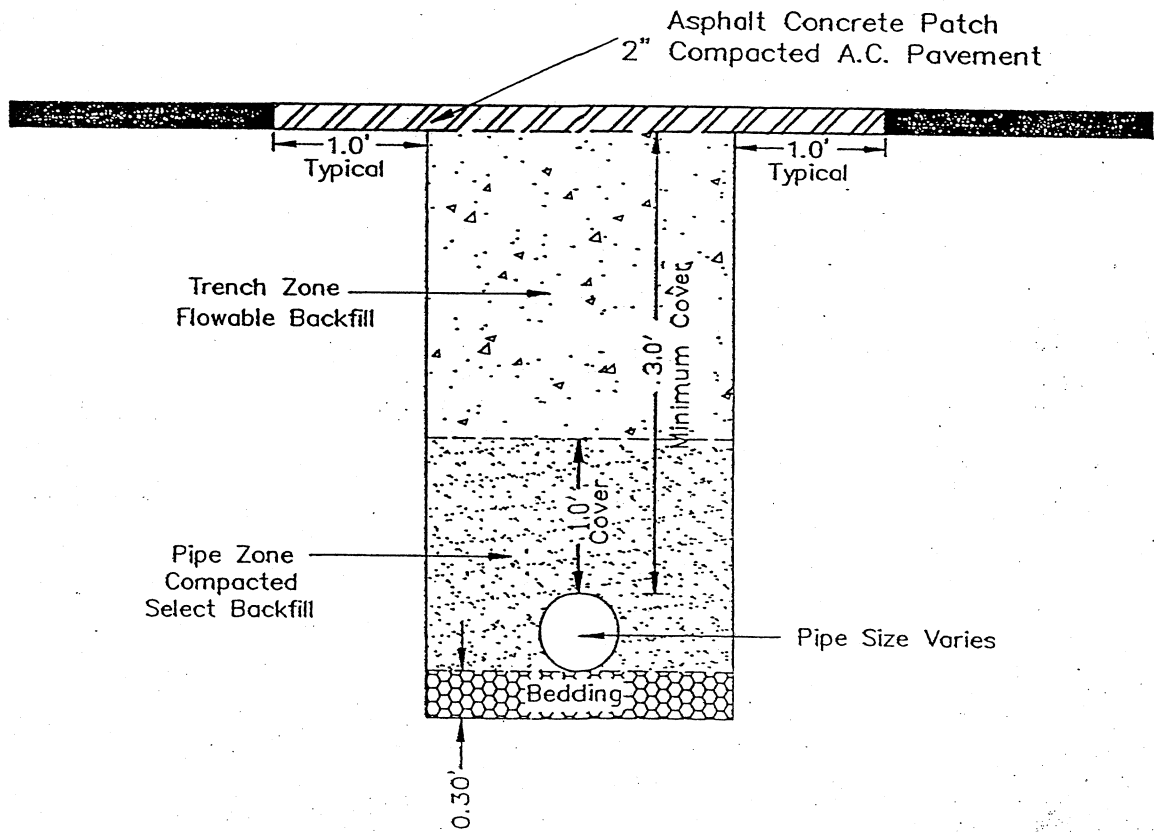

**WASCO COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS
UTILITY PERMIT GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. Submit a traffic control plan and work schedule prior to any work. Traffic plan to be approved by Wasco County.
- 2. Any trenching within the roadway, under a paved surface, must comply with the Flowable Backfill and AC Patch (Typical).
- 3. Any trenching within the roadway, under a gravel surface, must use suitable backfill material with proper compaction and replace any lost gravel surface.
- 4. If trenching across the County Road is allowed, no more than one-half of the traveled way is to be closed at one time.
- 5. Any AC cut in the travel lanes shall have steel plates placed over the cut until the Flowable Backfill has set.
- 6. Prior to patching an AC cut the surface shall be neatly cut with a pavement saw and the edges of the cut shall be tacked.
- 7. Any AC cut shall be patched no later than _____ days after completion of the utility work.
- 8. A **temporary** cold mix patch may be approved under certain conditions.
- 9. Contact Wasco County Public Works prior to AC patch or surfacing.
- 10. Upon completion of the installation, all debris, refuse and waste material that has accumulated because of the utility work shall be removed.
