
Summary: 175 words

Currently, Wasco County Commissioners are elected through a partisan nomination and election process, where candidates for County Commissioner are affiliated with political parties or run as independent candidates. This Ordinance, if approved, would amend the process to require candidates for the Office of Wasco County Commissioner to be elected on a nonpartisan basis, not affiliated with a political party. The Wasco County Board of Commissioners has referred this measure to the voters to make County Commissioner positions nonpartisan effective upon the approval by the voters of Wasco County.

RESULT OF YES VOTE: If this measure passes, County Commissioner positions will become nonpartisan.

RESULT OF NO VOTE: If this measure fails, candidates for County Commissioner will continue to be nominated from political parties.
