Community Planning Assistance for Wildfire Presentation:

Wasco County is one of eight communities selected through a nationwide competitive process to participate in the Community Planning Assistance for Wildfire (CPAW) program (<https://planningforwildfire.org>). The CPAW team is working with local fire and planning professionals to determine how Wasco County protects homes in the Wildland Urban Interface from the effects of Wildfire in an effort to identify successes that can be used in other communities, and provide tools for Wasco County to consider incorporating into their plans.
